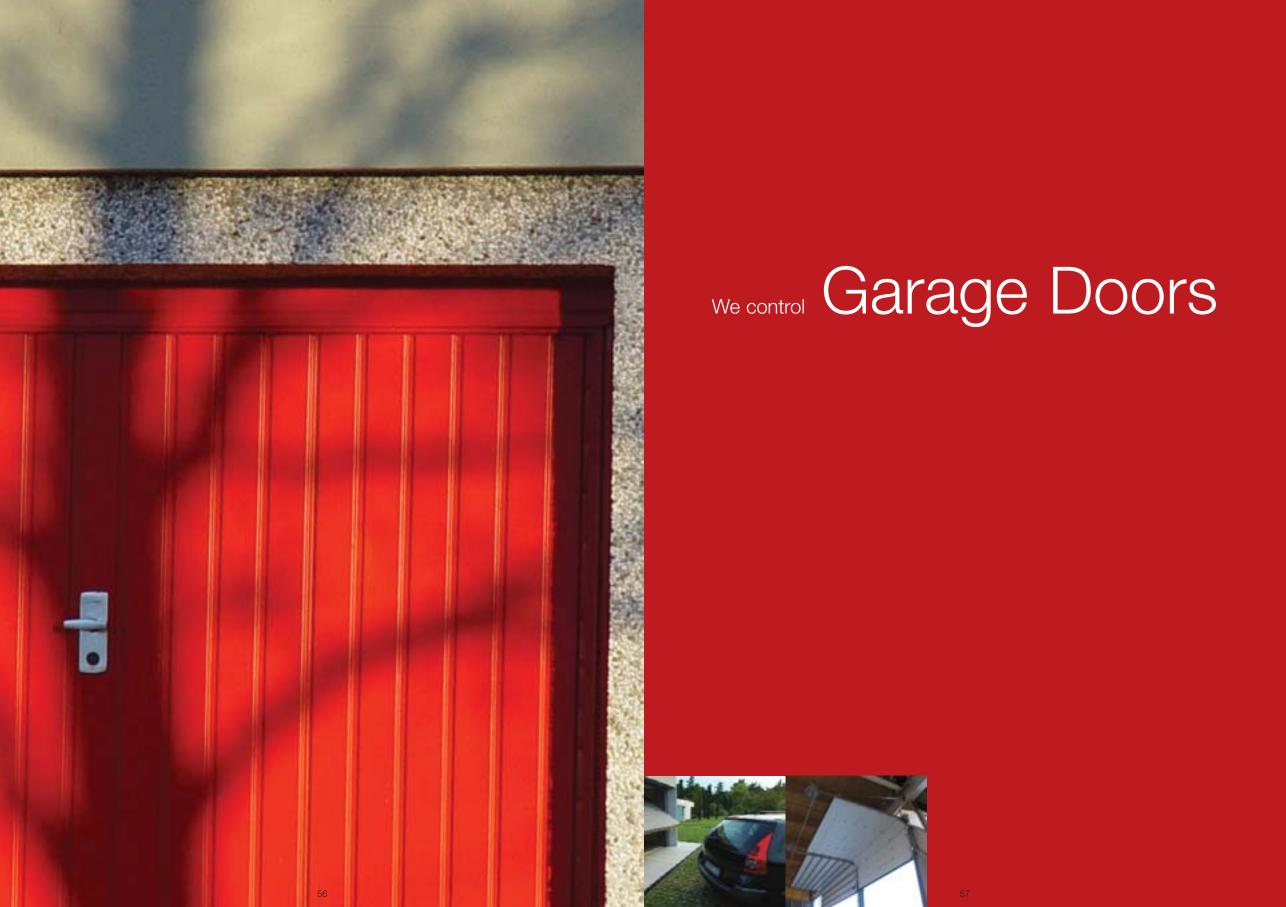
2. mouse, a mouse normally cunning (Mickey Mouse, Speedy Gonzales).

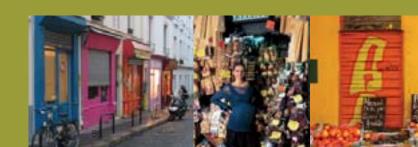

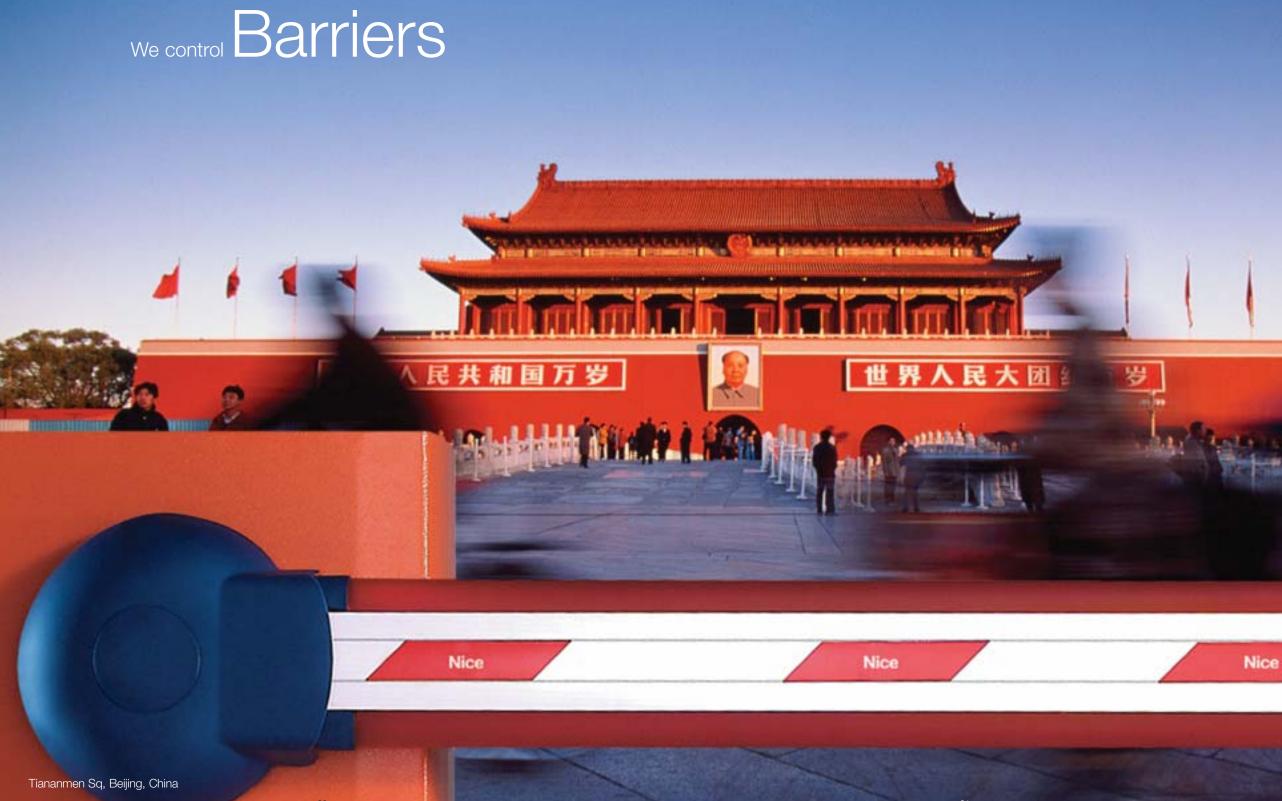
